**Sample requirement**      **3ml EDTA blood**      Samples must arrive within 24 hours of collection

Samples must be labelled at the patient's side immediately after being taken, using information from an ID wristband attached to the patient.

Label with; surname, forename, hospital number, date of birth, date and time of collection, signature (handwritten samples only). Two forms of labelling are acceptable;

- **Demand printed label** (eg BloodTrack)
  - Using the ID badge of the staff member who identified and bled the patient.
  - (other sticky labels are not acceptable).
- **Handwritten**
  - Written and signed by the person who identified and bled the patient.
